Learning Objectives

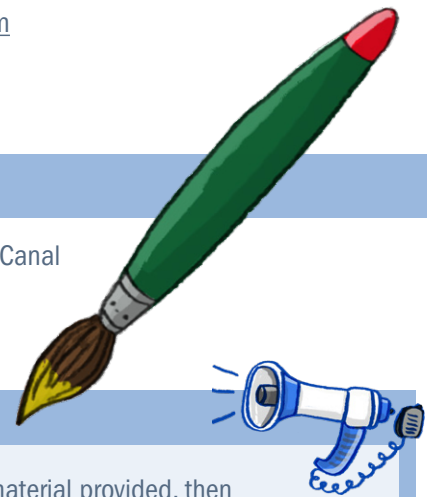
- To understand that landscapes change over time

Activity Instructions

Learners use paintings and photographs of the Dee Valley and Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Canal to create a collage landscape showing change over time. It is best done after the timeline activities to give some context.

Brief for Learners:



- Investigate the sources and material provided, then undertake further research on the time periods yourselves.
- Using what you have discovered, create a collage showing how the area around Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Canal has changed over time.
- Print and cut up images from the different time periods.
- Use different textures and materials to create your collage.
- Add quotes from the Travel Writing activity and data gathered from the population and mapping activities to add information to your change over time collage.
- Use the following questions to help shape your collage. What did the landscape look like? What has changed throughout the periods? What has stayed the same?

Further Activity Ideas:



Class debate: Did Pontcysyllte Aqueduct and Canal have a positive or negative impact on the landscape? What do you think people thought about it then? What do you think people think about it now?
